Key Scripture

“But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.” (John 4:23-24, NKJV)

Revelation Vision

This question came up for me when I was seeing the number 444 in my vision on 12/22/2019. I did not understand, but as God was showing me the spirit of a person I know, he then began to show me a string of people with the same spirit but manifested in different ways. Jezebel came up because of the wickedness that the Holy Spirit showed me about the person. The Holy Spirit began to show how I attracted the spirits and pointed me to the Samaritan woman in the bible.

I had so many personal questions about the bible that did not seem to get answered through traditional bible study, so as I hear the Holy Spirit teach. I started to get answers today which birthed another portion of daily bible study that I call “Revelation Bible Study”.

Bible Study Revelation and Lesson Learned

The question with the title is “What do they all have in common”? Through my studying the answer was revealed. They are different woman; in different times; in different situations but operate in the same disobedience to God. They are all dead, but their decisions they made demonstrated their physical ability to operate in the spirit of deception were identical. The Samaritan woman came the closest to the action of the Kingdom of God because she believed and went and told everyone.

In all things, pray for people with Jezebel spirits whether they are operating in her likeness or whether they are attached to the people of God. The people that follow her ways will have to deal face to face with God. I pray for God’s mercy because Jesus Christ cannot intercede

for people if they shut him out when he is clearly knocking on the door. It the spirit they operated from since Eve disobeyed God. You can see the spirit start off with a snake, but as of Revelation it is a dragon with fire spitting out of its mouth.

There physical behaviors in these areas showed who they served in the presence of the man God created. There were 4 areas I could see from scripture.

Jezebel

Jezebel used her physical power to be disobedient, seduce man and worship another god.

Jezebel spirit brings her culture of worship to the people in her environment. Her worship is not to God but many gods which is why she can manifest in so many different characteristics and traits in people.

Samaritan Woman

The Samaritan Woman showed us an example of how you can worship God in spirit when you know the truth which will shut down Jezebel. Some people know the truth, but still will not humble themselves and change. The truth can come through anyone even if they are a person that is not doing right in their flesh. If your flesh rises to truth, you have a choice to submit to the authority by the spirit or get angry.

Samaritan woman asked questions because she was curious and wanted to know more about the living water.

1. "How is it that You, being a Jew, ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman?" (John 4:9, NKJV)
2. "Sir, You have nothing to draw with, and the well is deep. Where then do You get that living water? ¹²Are You greater than our father Jacob, who gave us the well, and drank from it himself, as well as his sons and his livestock?" (John 4:11, NKJV)
3. "Sir, give me this water, that I may not thirst, nor come here to draw." (John 4:15, NKJV)
4. "Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet. (John 4:19, NKJV)

The Samaritan woman was exposed by Jesus, but she saw an example of what she had been believing although she was fornicating. She went to the well to draw physical water and was met with the living water she had been told about. She went to tell everyone. She saw a great light and ran to tell everyone.

The Samaritan woman is the example of the resurrected Eve coming back to worship the true God to shut down Jezebel's spirit.
